About WRFU

Mission Statement:

WRFU is a progressive radio station collective committed to social justice, focusing on public affairs issues and the arts. WRFU airs opinions and debates in an open and diverse forum that focuses on educating and empowering the public. WRFU provides an accessible venue for an eclectic mixture of arts programming.

Who We Are & What We Do:

WRFU is an Urbana-Champaign Independent Media Center (UCIMC) project and working group that operates a low-power FM community radio station. It has a license to broadcast issued by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The UCIMC has been empowering people to “become the media” for almost a decade by providing access to media resources and services, as well as proper training.

WRFU is governed on a consensus-based model that encourages a wide variety of local public affairs and arts programming. This open structure facilitates community engagement and provides no-barrier access to local media creation. WRFU also provides national, international and multi-lingual programming not regularly available in the community. The program schedule varies and is a product of community interests and participation.

Get Involved!

There are many ways to get involved at WRFU. To begin, attend a WRFU meeting, held every first Tuesday of the month at 8pm and third Saturday of the month at 1pm (UCIMC main space, 202 S. Broadway Ave. Urbana.).

WRFU membership is open to everyone, with an annual membership fee and orientation / training course.
